Foreword

There are many people and organizations in Heidelberg who work for refugees and migrants. So far, however, there has been no central overview of these different actors and their projects. This brochure aims to provide a first overview.

In this brochure, refugees, migrants and anyone interested can find a comprehensive collection of Heidelberg's initiatives, as well as important contacts and offices. It is primarily aimed at newcomers to help them arrive and find their way around Heidelberg. But this brochure is also intended to give an insight into the range of projects and services in Heidelberg to those who are involved in the field of flight and migration

As there is an abundance of stakeholders and projects in Heidelberg, we cannot guarantee that all of them are included in this brochure. Therefore, we would of course be pleased to receive feedback, comments or suggestions regarding missing or incorrect entries.

None of these offers, projects and initiatives in Heidelberg would be possible without the commitment of volunteers and full-time employees of the various institutions and authorities. We would therefore like to take this opportunity to thank all those who work for the people in Heidelberg.

A special thank you goes to everyone who contributed to the creation of this brochure.

Who we are:

The Migration Hub Heidelberg is a network in the Rhein-Neckar region that works on all layers of society in order to understand migration as a lived reality. This goal guides our work for migrants and their initiatives as well as for local agents, who are active in the field of migration and anti-racism. We give space to the perspective of people with migration history by supporting their engagement with need-based individual aid, networking and a provision of spaces. Our Hub serves as a physical place for civil society to exchange and cooperate towards sustainable and goal-oriented engagement.

- A) **Networking:** We connect actors in the area of flight and migration in Heidelberg through cooperation and networking projects. In particular, the network meetings we regularly organize serve as a platform that allows people to get to know each other and exchange ideas.
- B) **Individual support and support for initiatives:** We offer needs-based mentoring with the aim of strengthening the sustainability of local solutions. We particularly support migrant initiatives and projects, for example in the process of founding an association or in realizing their ideas.
- C) **Provision of rooms:** Our hub is an open space of mutual inspiration for partners and committed people.

Since the founding of the association in 2016, the foundations of the network were built, which currently comprises around 50 initiatives, projects and actors who are involved in flight and migration in Heidelberg.

Our cooperation partners:

For the project of the information brochure, we cooperate with the *Diakonisches Werk der Evangelischen Kirche in Heidelberg*, the *Caritasverband Heidelberg e.V.*, and the *Asylarbeitskreis e.V.* In addition, we are in contact with various other network partners to ensure the accuracy and relevance of the content with the help of experts. We are also supported by the Office for Equal Opportunities of the City of Heidelberg (Amt für Chancengleichheit).

Solidarity City Heidelberg:

Manifesto for a City Based on Solidarity

We as Migration Hub Heidelberg are part of the Solidarity City Heidelberg and support the manifesto for a city of solidarity.

According to the municipal code of Baden-Württemberg, the municipality promotes the common good of its inhabitants through civic self-administration.

The municipal code makes no distinction between its inhabitants, but in reality, there are many barriers and grievances that prevent inclusion and participation.

We demand that Heidelberg enforces fundamental rights for everyone:

- For all people in this city, regardless of their financial opportunities, attributed origin, gender, sexuality, corporeality,
- The same basic human rights to social, societal and political participation apply to everyone regardless of residence status, age or religion and without any restrictions.
- All people in this city have fundamental rights enabling them to meet their existential needs, food, housing, medical care and education.
- Equal access to social infrastructure, e.g. work, cultural participation, mobility must be guaranteed.
- We demand political participation for all people in Heidelberg.
- All people have the right to cultural, religious, gender and sexual self-determination.
- All people who live in Heidelberg should have the right to stay.
- Heidelberg is to be a shelter for people in need and open to refugees.
- We recognize a particular responsibility of the authorities and institutions to reduce barriers and structural racism.
- We fight against discrimination and structural and civil racism.

1 Advice and Information

There are many contact points in Heidelberg that offer general advice and information for people in different situations. These services are open to everyone. These general counselling services are the first places to go when you do not know who to turn to. Frequently, they refer you to other contacts, services and institutions that are specialized in certain topics or offer further support and assistance. In this brochure we have collected many specialized advice and contact points for you. However, we do not claim to be exhaustive.

In addition, there are a lot of **specialized advice centers**. They can refer you to other services, institutions, offices and authorities. Counselling in these institutions is impartial, confidential, free-of-charge and always voluntary.

If you need legal support, it is important to know that the counselling centers work together with lawyers on a regular basis. Through these specialized advice centers, you can be referred to a free legal advice center in individual cases. Furthermore, you can find the address of lawyers in your area on the homepage of the [Flüchtlings-Rat Baden-Württemberg](#) (Refugee Council). The Asylarbeitskreis Heidelberg e.V., the Caritasverband Heidelberg e.V. and the *Dia-konisches Werk der Evangelischen Kirche in Heidelberg* also offer counselling appointments for questions regarding residence and asylum law. The Student Legal Advice - Pro Bono e.V. prepares you for the hearing before the Federal Office for Migration and Refugees (BAMF) - free of charge.

2 Basic Services

A fresh start at a new location is always difficult. In this chapter you will find information regarding your most important needs and those who can help you with them immediately after your arrival in Heidelberg.

There are two organizations for people with low income which offer food at reasonable prices after registration: Brot & Salz in the old town of Heidelberg and Rat und Tat St. Elisabeth in Heidelberg-Südstadt (southern part of town). There are also various food sharing offers such as the Fair-Teiler which allow private individuals to share food with one another.

Finding an apartment in a foreign city can often be intimidating. Therefore, there are various initiatives that support newcomers (especially refugees) with their search for accommodation. These include the *Asylarbeitskreis Heidelberg e.V.* and the *Diakonisches Werk der Evangelischen Kirche Heidelberg*. Apart from that you can reach out to local networks like *Weststadt sagt Ja*, *Kirchheim sagt Ja*, *FlüchtlingspartnerInnen Ziegelhausen und Handschuhsheim* that offer help with finding accommodation.

Various thrift shops in Heidelberg offer used clothing. There are also active Facebook groups where clothes are sold or given away. Furniture can also be purchased cheaply or secondhand in Heidelberg.

You are mobile in Heidelberg even without a car and can easily get around the city by public transport. Tickets, including reduced social tickets, are available at the RNV Customer Service Centre and selling points. Heidelberg is also a bike-friendly city, so cycling is an easy and inexpensive alternative. There are many bike shops where you can buy new and used bikes.

3 Language

There are many opportunities to learn German in Heidelberg. First you should decide how much time and money you want to invest in the language course, whether you need a formal qualification (for example for work or university) or if you want to learn German in order to get along better in everyday life.

The office for equal opportunities (*Amt für Chancengleichheit*) of the city of Heidelberg created a brochure that gives you an overview on the different kinds of language courses. It is available in seven languages on the website of the city of Heidelberg. It also tells you if and how you can participate in an integration course - a formal language course for which you can get an official certificate of completion.

There are also language courses in Heidelberg that are free of charge. Various organizations teach German in groups or individually, and you can usually join a course right away. These organizations can help you prepare for a German exam. However, they do not issue certificates themselves.

The *University of Heidelberg* also offers language support through its international study center (*Internationales Studierendenzentrum*) as part of the preparation for studying in Germany.

In order to improve your German for everyday life, there are many opportunities to meet people, for example by cooking together, doing sports or attending cultural events. If you do not yet feel comfortable with the German language but want to or, need to make official appointments, for example with the authorities, the volunteers of the language network (*Sprachmittlernetzwerk*) can help you. They will accompany you to these appointments and can translate and act as interpreters for you.

4 Work and Apprenticeship

In many cases it is not possible to find work immediately after arriving in Heidelberg. The entry into professional life often depends on residence permits, technical and language skills and job availability. Furthermore, not every foreign degree is equivalent to a German degree of the same profession. You will need special advice and usually special training and qualifications in order to start looking for a job with a degree that is recognized by Germany.

There are counselling offers for job seekers in all situations: the employment agency (*Arbeitsamt*) is a focal counselling centre for all topics related to work, training and further education. *Diakonisches Werk der Evangelischen Kirche in Heidelberg*, *Caritasverband* and the *Asylarbeitskreis Heidelberg* can also provide job counselling for refugees with residence status. The *Heidelsberger Netzwerk für Integration und Anerkennung* (Network for Integration and Recognition) and *IKUBIZ* in Mannheim can help with foreign degrees. You can find work at the *Jobcenter* or apply for unemployment benefits.

5 Education

In Germany, compulsory schooling applies to all children from the age of six. Attending a public school is free of charge in Germany.

Refugee children must start visiting a school at the latest six months after their arrival in Germany. At this time, You will receive a letter from the closest school suggesting an appointment to discuss your child's enrolment. If you do not get a letter you have to register at the closest school in your area. An aid organization, such as the *Asylarbeitskreis Heidelberg*, can also help you place your children in a suitable school. There are welcome classes for children who do not yet speak German fluently. Here the children can focus on learning German before they take part in the regular classes.

You can find an overview of all schools in Heidelberg in the [official school guide](#).

[Here](#) you can also find special educational schools and counselling centers. There are many organizations in Heidelberg that help children, young people and their parents when they have difficulties at school. Many of these organizations specialize in migrants and/or refugees. For children and adolescents who need help at school, there are many organizations that offer tutoring free of charge and might also provide 1-on-1 mentoring.

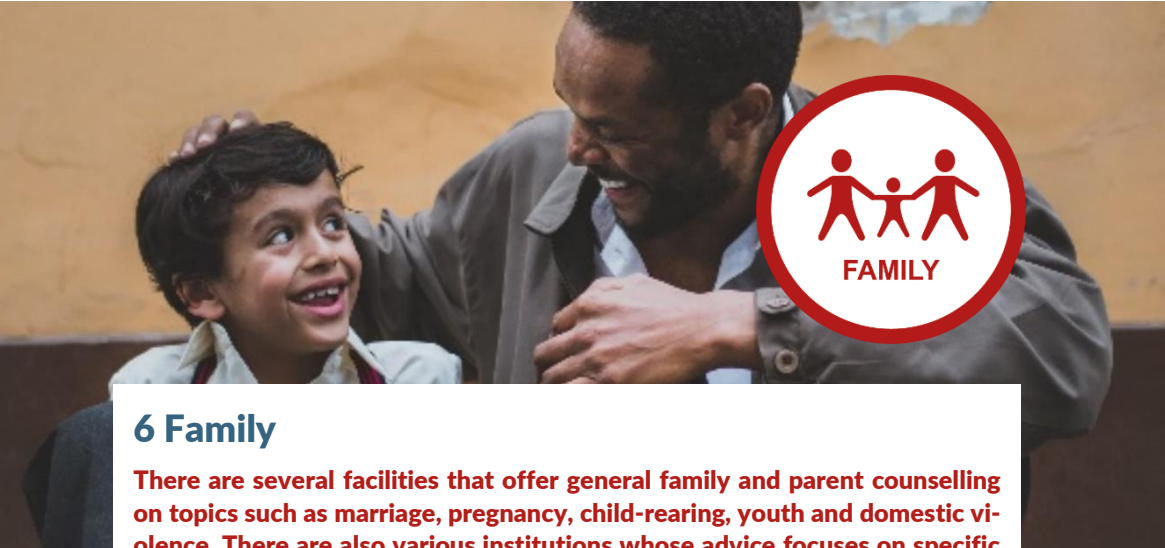

6 Family

There are several facilities that offer general family and parent counselling on topics such as marriage, pregnancy, child-rearing, youth and domestic violence. There are also various institutions whose advice focuses on specific topics. The children's and youth welfare office (Kinder- und Jugendamt) of the city of Heidelberg helps parents by providing advice at nurseries. The youth agency (Jugendagentur) offers advice and coaching for young people and parents regarding education and transition into work-life.

Chapters 4 (Work & Education) and 5 (Education) provide detailed information on school and education. Chapter 10 (Leisure activities) contains further information on sports and other leisure activities.

If you have any questions about (unwanted) pregnancy, childbirth and family planning, the *Diakonisches Werk Heidelberg*, the *Sozialdienst Katholischer Frauen (SkF)* and *Pro Familia*, among others, are available for advice. The *Internationale Frauen- und Familienzentrum Heidelberg* offers advice on pregnancy especially for immigrant women and their families. All these organizations are officially recognized and are subject to confidentiality - which means that the things you say in a conversation there will not be revealed to anyone else.

There are youth clubs and youth centers for children and adolescents in the city districts. They offer free leisure activities for children and young people of all ages. These include music and sports offers, courses and workshops as well as rooms for holding private parties. Many of these institutions also offer tutoring or help with homework. They are often open on weekends and offer activities during the holidays.

For offers regarding senior citizens, we recommend the guide on older people (*Wegweiser für ältere Menschen*) which can be obtained from city institutions. There are also senior centers all around the city that offer space for cultural exchange. In the same way, the *Mehrgenerationenhaus* is a place to meet, connect and share experiences.

7 Women

Many organizations are specifically geared towards the living conditions and needs of women. Information on pregnancy and family can be found in chapter 6 (Family).

Women who experience violence within the family or relationship can reach out to various organizations and services such as the women's shelter (*Frauenhaus*), the women's emergency hotline (*Frauennotruf*) or the women's health center (*FrauenGesundheitsZentrum Heidelberg*). These services offer psychological counselling and support. They also offer general health advice for women and support for single women and mothers. Everyone working in these institutions are subject to confidentiality - which means that the things you say in a conversation there will not be revealed to anyone else. If there is an acute situation of violence, reach out to the police by calling 110.

The counselling centre *Anna* of the *Diakonisches Werk* supports people in prostitution regardless of the circumstances. The health office (*Gesundheitsamt*) of the *administrative district office of the Rhein-Neckar-Kreis* also offers health advice. Clubs and groups such as the *Heidelberg International Women's Club* offer space for exchange and constructive encounters through leisure activities specifically for women.

The city Heidelberg also published, in cooperation with the public health office, the so-called '[Heidelberger Gesundheitswegweiser für MigrantInnen und Migranten](#)' on the Rhein-Neckar-Kreis/Heidelberg newspaper. The guide contains information on where you can find medical help in your native language. It is available in English, Turkish, and Arabic in all municipal offices in Heidelberg, the public health office of Heidelberg, counselling centres for migrants and online.

People who are in the midst of their asylum process and/or who do not have a secure residence status will not have full access to the German healthcare system. In the reception centers for immigrants (Erstaufnahmeeinrichtungen) such as the Patrick-Henry-Village (PHV) arrival centre Heidelberg, there are medical ambulances intended for medical emergencies. If the asylum procedure is not completed and you have not been in Germany for 15 months, you should reach out to the social service (Sozialdienst) assigned to you in case of any health-related questions.

The association *MediNetz Rhein Neckar e.V.* also provides anonymous referrals to medical treatment for people without insurance and without charging you. After your first contact with MediNetz they will organize free appointments or a reduced price for you at a doctor's office or a hospital. The offer is for everyone, regardless of their origin or residence status.

For people with a permanent residence there is a network of psychiatric services (*Gemeindepsychiatrie-Verbund*) especially for those who seek help close to their residence. There are regional counselling centers in Baden-Württemberg such as the association *Verein zur Unterstützung traumatisierter Migranten e.V. in Karlsruhe* that offer help to migrants that have suffered trauma, especially for those who experienced flight and displacement.

9 Discrimination

Discrimination is the disadvantage, degradation and unequal treatment of a person or group based on prejudice and without any justification. For example, people may be discriminated against based on their origin, religion, sexuality, disability, gender, or age. Discrimination can occur anytime and anywhere, including Germany. But it is important to know: equal treatment is a fundamental right, discrimination is prohibited by law and you can take action against it. Therefore, it is important to understand how discrimination works and be aware of your rights in order to protect yourself and others.

The General Equal Treatment Act (Allgemeines Gleichbehandlungsgesetz, AGG), or anti-discrimination law, is a law in Germany intended to “prevent and eliminate disadvantages based on race or ethnic origin, gender, religion or belief, disability, age or sexual identity”. You can rely on the AGG for example in case of unequal treatment in the areas of career entry, working conditions, vocational training, social protection, education or your search for accommodation, and bring charges against those who discriminated against you.

Various institutions and organizations can support you. The office for equal opportunities (*Amt für Chancengleichheit*) of the city of Heidelberg is committed to equality for all citizens in all areas of life and can advise you if you experience discrimination. The office can forward your case to other counselling and service points. There is an online form through which you can report a case of discrimination on the website of the municipal office against discrimination (*Kommunale Antidiskriminierungsstelle*) which belongs to the Amt für Chancengleichheit. The anti-discrimination office HD.net respect! is also an active counselling centre in cases of discrimination. The university and the university of education (*Pädagogische Hochschule*) also have offices for equality that fight against discrimination.

10 Protection against violence

The city will support you if you experience ongoing and/or impending violence. In order to get support, you can contact various services that either advise you directly or refer you to other groups or institutions. These can help you find emergency accommodation, mediate psychosocial or legal advice and provide primary medical care.

In cases of emergencies, you can always contact the police and emergency medical services free of charge using the telephone numbers listed. If you have experienced violence on a personal level and are seeking immediate relief, there are some initiatives for aftercare and advice that can take care of you and any affected children. These include the women's shelter (Frauenhaus) or the child protection center (Kinderschutzzentrum). A number of focal points are also available for the concerns of men affected by violence.

If you want to remain anonymous with regard to such topics, you can also contact the corresponding emergency hotlines such as the *Frauennotruf*, through which you can be advised, supported and accompanied confidentially and free of charge and for an unlimited period.

11 Leisure Activities

Sports and leisure activities make first time experiences and settling into a new place easier. Over 120 sports clubs in Heidelberg offer both children and adults plenty of opportunities to engage in physical activities and get in touch with others - regardless of their background and experience.
